<i>Definitions</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the following terms and conditions, the word ‘accreditation’ applies to the application for the Level 1 Associate Practitioner Status. 2. The accreditation process is a principles-based assessment of an applicant’s theoretical knowledge of social value and impact management in line with the SVI Framework. 3. ‘The application’ refers to completion of: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The online application form where applicants can submit: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. signed Commitment to Good Practice. ii. statement of interest in Social Value and SROI. iii. signed Terms & Conditions. b. the SVI Social Value and Impact Management exam 4. The Assurance Provider refers to Social Value UK who provide assurance and accreditation services on behalf of Social Value International
<i>Making an application</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Social Value UK provide the SVI Practitioner Pathway accreditation service as an Assurance Centre of Social Value International. 6. To apply for accreditation the applicant must hold a current membership of Social Value International, either directly or through a Joint Member Network before the point of application. 7. This is an individual accreditation application. It is not possible for an organisation to apply for this accreditation. 8. The application must be fully completed including all required documents or it will not be accepted. 9. Applicants must complete the Social Value and Impact Management exam by no later than 1 week before the results round for their results to be released in the respective round. 10. Payment for accreditation will be taken in full via invoice. This invoice must be paid before results of accreditation can be released to the applicant. 11. Applications will be processed in order of the dates on which they are received. 12. Applications can be made at any time throughout the year; however, results will only be released during results windows as outlined in the results section this document. 13. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure that all the

	<p>requirements for application are met.</p> <p>14. Applications that do not meet all requirements, are not complete or do not meet the stated deadlines will be returned and a new application must be resubmitted.</p> <p>15. Complete applications that cannot be assessed due to high demand will be retained and given priority in the next round.</p> <p>16. Applications must be made in English.</p> <p>17. Results of the application will not be released without confirmed payment.</p>
<i>Assessment Process and Results</i>	<p>18. The exam will be marked by the assurance provider using a combination of internal and external assessors.</p> <p>19. The exam will be marked based on criteria developed by Social Value International.</p> <p>20. The exam can have the following results:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. 70% and above in all sections – Pass.ii. 69% and below – Fail. Applicant will be able to re-sit exam as part of a new application. <p>21. Results will be sent to applicants during the results rounds. The results rounds take place 4 times a year. Dates for the rounds can be found on the Assurance Calendar on the Social Value UK website.</p> <p>22. Results will include a summary of marks scored in each section and overall.</p>
