

SVI Practitioner Application Rounds

Number of rounds:

There will be 4 results rounds for Level 1 Associate Practitioner applications in 2021.

There will be 4 application rounds for Level 2 Accredited Practitioner and Level 3 Advanced Practitioner applications in 2021.

Levels of SVI Practitioner status:

The SVI Practitioner Pathway is a professional development pathway. There are 3 levels for becoming an SVI Practitioner:

- Level 1: Associate Practitioner: Demonstrated theoretical competence in social value and impact management in line with the SVI Framework
- Level 2: Accredited Practitioner: Demonstrated practical competence in the application of social impact and social value assessment in line with the SVI Framework
- Level 3: Advanced Practitioner: Advanced demonstration of practical competence in the application
 of social impact and social value assessment with all aspects of SVI Framework applied in full.

Application for Level 1: Associate Practitioner:

Level 1: Associate Practitioner applicants will be tested on their theoretical knowledge. This will be tested through an online Social Value and Impact Management exam.

Applicants can apply for Level 1: Associate Practitioner status at any time through the year, and undertake the online exam when most convenient for them.

PLEASE NOTE: Payment for applications is taken through the exam website.

Applications will be assessed by the Assurance Team, and results will be released during 4 rounds through the year. The round will be during the second week of the Report Assurance round as follows:

Round 1: January 2021

L1 AP Results will be released between Monday 25th and Friday 29th January

Round 2: April 2021

L1 AP Results will be released between Monday 19th and Friday 23rd April

Round 3: July 2021

L1 AP Results will be released between Monday 12th and Friday 16th July

Round 4: October 2021

L1 AP Results will be released between Monday 25th and Friday 29th October



Application for Level 2: Accredited Practitioner and Level 3: Advanced Practitioner:

Level 2 and Level 3 Practitioners will be tested on their practical competence in the application of social impact and social value assessment in line with the SVI Framework. Level 3: Advanced Practitioner will show advanced demonstration of practical competence in the application of social impact and social value assessment with all aspects of SVI Framework applied in full.

Assurance and Accreditation Steps:

The accreditation process runs through the following steps:

- **1.** Applicant submits SVI Level 2 or 3 Practitioner application including report for assurance with supporting documentation
- 2. Assurance Team undertake first review of application and will communicate results to applicant within 1 week of end of round.
- **3.** If report passes first review report is submitted for full anonymous assessment with external assessor. Applicant will receive their invoice.
- 4. External assessor returns feedback for review by assurance team
- **5.** First results are sent to applicant and external assessor and applicant are put in touch. This will take place within 5-6 weeks from application date

At this stage applicants can have 3 different results:

- Report Assured
- Report does not meet the assurance standard criteria, but can with an amendment period
- Report does not meet the assurance standard criteria
- **6.** If an applicant receives the result: 'Report does not meet the assurance standard criteria, but can with an amendment period' then Applicant and assessor communicate about feedback (recommendation for telephone call, but can be done over email)
- **7.** Applicant confirms if they are taking their amendment period or not. SVI will issue the applicants amendment period invoice to applicant.
- **8.** If taking the amendment period the applicant can amend their report and liaise with their assessor until they are happy they meet all of the necessary criteria and resubmit their report to the Assurance Team for final assurance
- **9.** If the report passes the final assurance assessment, then assurance of the report will be provided with the possibility of the following 2 results:
 - Report Assured
 - Report Assured with Limitation of the application of Principle 4: Only include what is material

At this stage applicants will need to undertake an interview with the Assurance Team and their external assessor.

10. Applicants will undertake an interview which will test their overall knowledge of Social Value and Impact Management, and with specific questions related to the analysis they are using as a part of their application. The interview will be between 1-2 hours. The interview will take place between 1 and 3 weeks after their final report assurance result.

PLEASE NOTE: All invoices for assurance services operate on a 10-day net payment terms. Results of assurance engagements cannot be released until payment is received.

Amendment invoice issued w/c 21st July

Amendment results expected by 30th July

Interview week - Monday 9th - Friday 13th August

Round 3: Sept/Oct 2021

Round opens for applications - Monday 6th September

Round closes – Friday 17th September

Applications assigned to assessors – Monday 20th September

Invoices issued – Tuesday 21st September

Assessors to return results by – Friday 8th October

Invoice paid by – Sunday 10th October

Results released to applicants – Monday 11th – 15th October

Amendment period if needed – 5 weeks – ends on 19th November

Amendment invoice issued w/c 18th October

Amendment results expected by 26th November

Round 4: Nov/Dec 2021

Round opens for applications – Monday 8th November

Round closes – Friday 19th November

Applications assigned to assessors – Monday 22nd November

Invoices issued – Tuesday 23rd November

Assessors to return results by – Friday 10th December

Invoice paid by – Sunday 12th December

Results released to applicants – Monday 13th to Friday 17th December

Amendment period if needed – 5 weeks – ends on 4th February 2022 (longer amendment period due to holidays)

Amendment invoice issued beginning of January 2022

Amendment results expected by 11th February 2022

Interview week – Monday 14th – Friday 18th February 2022
