	2. The accreditation process is a principles-based assessment of an applicant's theoretical
	knowledge of social value and impact management in line with the SVI Framework.
	3. 'The application' refers to completion of:
	a. The online application form where applicants can submit:
	i. signed Commitment to Good Practice.
	ii. signed Terms and Conditions.
	b. the SVI Social Value and Impact Management exam.
	 The Assurance Provider refers to Social Value UK who provide assurance and accreditation services on behalf of Social Value International.
Making an application	5. Social Value UK provide the SVI Practitioner Pathway accreditation service as an Assurance Centre of Social Value International.
	6. To apply for accreditation the applicant must hold a current membership of
	Social Value International, either directly or through a Joint Member Network
	before the point of application.
	 This is an individual accreditation application. It is not possible for an organisation to apply for this accreditation.
	8. The application must be fully completed including all required documents or it will
	not be accepted.
	9. Payment for accreditation will be taken in full via invoice or card payment.
	Payment must be made before results of accreditation can be released to the applicant.
	10. Applications will be processed in order of the dates on which they are received.
	11. Applications can be made at any time throughout the year.
	12. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure that all the
	requirements for application are met.
	13. Applications that do not meet all requirements will be returned and a new
	application must be resubmitted.
	14. Applications must be made in English.
	15. Results of the application will not be released without confirmed payment.

Assessment Process and Results	16. The exam will be marked by the assurance provider using a combination of internal and external assessors.
	17. The exam will be marked based on criteria developed by Social Value International.
	18. Results will be shared with applicants within 10 working days of exam submission.
	19. Results will include a summary of marks scored in each section and overall.
	20. The exam can have the following results:
	 An overall score of 70% or above, with a minimum of 50% in each section – Pass.
	 ii. An overall score of less than 70%, or a score of less than 50% in any section – Fail. Applicant will be able to re-sit exam as part of a new application.
